VI. Conclusion (**6:11-18**)

- These verses serve as a summary of the main lessons of the letter – some commentators refer to these verses as the “interpretive clue” and “hermeneutical key” to the whole letter.
- Except for the final verse (**v. 18**), these final verses form a final rebuke of the false teachers and exhortation for the Galatians.
- Paul is again imploring them to believe in the only true gospel – there are only 2 paths to be on – the one to heaven or the one to hell!
